

- Only verified vaccinated individuals will be permitted entry to the concert halls. Camerata Pacifica must have a copy of your vaccination card on file. If you have attended a Camerata event in 2021, we have a copy of your vaccination card. If you are uncertain, call the Camerata office at (805) 884 8410 to check.
- Camerata Pacifica will not release vaccination records, they will remain confidential.
- We will require names, contact information, and have a copy of the vaccination card of everyone for whom you are purchasing tickets. For instance, if 4 tickets are purchased, we will need information for all 4 guests.
- For tickets purchased at the door. You will need to provide your vaccination card, and permit Camerata Pacifica to make a copy. Contact information will be required for every member of your party.
- At this moment masks are required at every venue. Those guidelines can be expected to change. Venue rules will take precedence over CDC guidelines. The following are prohibited: Masks with exhalation valves; masks made of loosely woven fabrics; scarves, buffs, bandanas, gaiters, and face shields alone (inadequate protection).

- Don't worry if you arrive to the venue having forgotten your mask we'll have K95 masks available.
- Social distancing: if you are a previous subscriber, and have chosen your previously held seats, you will be seated close to others, probably your friends. To permit social distancing, only 50% of the remaining tickets will be available for sale.
- Contact tracing. If you test positive for Covid-19 within 14
  days of a performance you attended, please contact the
  Camerata office immediately. Without identifying you,
  we will notify the venue and other audience members
  of their potential exposure to the virus.
- Camerata Pacifica musicians will be tested before traveling to California and, with staff, regularly tested throughout the rehearsal and performance period.

Please note, if you arrive to a performance without verifying your vaccinated status, you will not be permitted entry. If masks are required, and you do not properly wear your mask, covering your nose and mouth, you will be asked to leave.

We reserve the right to amend and modify these protocols and guidelines. We will attempt to provide as much notice as possible of any changes.

Please forgive the rather formal nature of this notice. The Camerata community is a special one, therefore we don't anticipate any issues asking for common sense consideration of each other. However, we also want to reassure you that we'll take every opportunity to make sure you're safe and feel relaxed while in our concert spaces.
