### **Position Summary**

As our principal production team member, the Manager of Production (MP) is responsible for achieving the highest level of professional production values for all Camerata Pacifica presentations. The MP liaises with vendors, venues, artists, stage crew members, the Artistic Director, staff, and other partners, and is a highly collaborative team member.

## Responsibilities

- Supervise all aspects of the production of Camerata Pacifica concerts and events, and serve as stage manager for all performances
- Manage stage crew including maintaining crew roster, scheduling and monitoring work, and facilitating payment of wages and reimbursements
- Oversee and maintain all company-owned equipment including company vehicle
- Source and coordinate equipment rentals including instruments, lighting and sound packages, and other production elements and materials
- Serve as principal contact for artists and coordinate their travel, local transportation, accommodations, and backstage hospitality
- Own and maintain all production schedules and artist itineraries
- Assist with general office administration and projects such as processing ticket orders, mailings, program book production, record keeping, BMI/ASCAP reporting, and other projects as needed
